Discipleship is something intensely personal and dynamic. It entails ongoing conversion, transformation, and continually learning to say a greater "Yes" to Jesus...They're intentionally trying to imitate Christ.

This journey of transformation involves a disciple humbly recognizing two important truths:

- A. The truth about himself his many weaknesses, failures, and areas where he falls short of living like Christ.
- B. The truth about what he's made for be conformed to the image of Christ: living like him, loving like him.

Discipleship is all about moving from A to B.

Over the next month, think about what you are made for. Think about what you were created for. Note that this is different than your roles in life – husband, friend, parent, etc. – this is about why God created you, uniquely you, to be a part of His creation. Need some inspiration? Let's go to the source – God's Word. Check out a few of these scriptures!

(But remember, God's word is meant to be savored and put into context so pull out that Bible and read how the verses below speak in the larger Story!)

Consider praying for your partner this month about what they are made for.

Jeremiah 31:3 I have loved you with an everlasting love; I have drawn you with loving-kindness.

Philippians 2:13 For it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure.

Matthew 37-39 And he said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the great and first commandment. And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself.

Matthew 5:16 Let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.

"In commanding us to glorify Him, God is inviting us to enjoy Him." – Quote by C.S. Lewis

1 Corinthians 10:31 So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.

Titus 3:2 to speak evil of no one, to avoid quarreling, to be gentle, and to show perfect courtesy toward all people.

Ecclesiastes 12:13 The end of the matter; all has been heard. Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man.

Revelation 4:11 You are worthy, O Lord, To receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, And by Your will they exist and were created.

Micah 6:8 He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?
